
How it Works! Mix Me Up

What you will need:

- o Bank paper
- Acrylic paints
- Brushes and rollers
- o Art bank
- Coloured paper
- o Old books,
- Used exercise books
- Newspaper
- Water colours
- Oil pastels
- o Charcoal
- o Ink pen
- Stencils
- o Bubble wrap
- o Glue

How to do it:


- 1. Plan your idea (template available)
- 2. Create a background using acrylic paint
- 3. Choose and cut collage pieces from art bank and glue onto art piece
- 4. Colour or shade shapes with oil pastels
- 5. Outline shapes with charcoal or pastel, blend
- 6. Stamp onto art piece with paint
- 7. Stencil over art with bubble wrap or similar
- 8. Choose a quote or create text to add
- 9. Write or stamp onto paper and cut or tear
- 10. Glue onto artwork and outline and shade
- 11. Stand back and admire your work
