

How it Works!

Silhouette Portrait

What you will need:

- Acrylic paints
- o Profile bust digital image
- o PVA glue
- Sandpaper
- Recycled book or magazine
- o Gesso
- o Impasto gel
- Black marker
- Scissors
- o Ruler
- Cereal box or similar

How to do it:

- 1. Rip up book or magazine and glue to cardboard to create a working surface.
- 2. Coat with Impasto gel
- 3. Coat with gesso
- 4. Coat with chosen acrylic colour
- 5. Vary the tint and tone but remember monochromatic colour
- 6. Sand the surface to create an interesting texture.
- 7. Print silhouette, paint reverse side black
- 8. When dry, cut out and glue on prepared surface paint side up.
- 9. Trim the sides and & create a border.
